COMMITTEE REPORTS

Beginning balance \$37,425.54, receipts of 730.56, disbursements of \$10,373.29 for an ending balance of \$27,782.81, which combined with our savings balance of \$38,411.09, gave the club a total balance at the end of December of \$66,193.90.

501(c)(3) Status. Cheryl Kienast reported that the application has been received by the IRS and that it could take some time before there is a response.

Show Committee. Carol reported that the Judges' Selection Committee had met and settled on the panel. Since our show this year will fall on Halloween, discussion was held about holding some kind of costume contest.

Agility. Agility trial will be held in February in Harriman.

Website. Following discussion, Erin Lonas made a **MOTION** that we purchase Cognitoforms Software for \$230. Jan Flaherty seconded. **Motion carried unopposed**.

Nominating Committee. Jan Flaherty will Chair the committee, the following members will be contacted to see if they would serve: Lois Biedron, Pat Symons, Gwen Weaver, Susan Corum and Tami Bradford, with Nina Van Camp as an alternate.

FastCAT. Debby Hodges reported that we will again offer this activity this year.

RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS SUPERINTENDENTS AND SHOW SECRETARIES

CHAPTER 9

SECTION 2. Any qualified person may make application to The American Kennel Club for approval to act as Show Secretary of a dog show.

There is no limit on the number of Specialty Shows for which an individual may be approved Show Secretary. An individual will be approved as Show Secretary for the show or shows of only one group or one all-breed club in a calendar year. An individual must hold a license from The American Kennel Club as Superintendent in order to be approved as Superintendent for more than one group or one all-breed club in a calendar year.

CHAPTER 9

SECTION 2. Any qualified person may make application to The American Kennel Club for approval to act as Show Secretary of a dog show.

There is no limit on the number of Specialty Shows for which an individual may be approved Show Secretary. An individual shall be approved as Show Secretary for the show or shows of only one group or one all-breed club and any group or all-breed show held on the same day and site of the club in a calendar year. An individual must hold a license from The American Kennel Club as Superintendent in order to be approved as Superintendent for more than one group or one all-breed club and events held the same day and site with the club in a calendar year.

This amendment was presented by Staff to the Board based on a request by a member of the Board of Directors.

This change will allow for an individual to be approved as a Show Secretary for the events held by one all-breed or group club and any additional events held the same day and site as the club in a calendar year.

RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS MEASURING, WEIGHING AND COLOR DETERMINATIONS WHEN FACTORS OF DISQUALIFICATION IN BREED STANDARDS OR ELIGIBLITY UNDER THE CONDITIONS OF A CLASS OR DIVISION OF A CLASS CANCELLATION OF AWARDS

CHAPTER 14

SECTION 5. Event Committees shall be responsible for providing suitable equipment for determining eligibility with respect to height and accurate scales at every show.

Event Committees for all-breed shows, or superintendents, if given this responsibility by the Event-Committees, shall be required to have two large (17" 30") wickets and two small (8" 17") wickets available at every all-breed dog show. Event-Committees for specialty shows, or superintendents, if delegated this responsibility by the Event-Committees, shall be responsible for having one wicket or the one set of wickets applicable to that breed, available at every show.

Clubs located in Alaska, Hawaii and Puerto Rico, as well as those clubs in the continental United States that have less than 1,000 entries at their events, shall be required to have one complete set of wickets (1 large, 1 small) available.

CHAPTER 14

SECTION 5. Event Committees shall be responsible for providing suitable equipment meeting all AKC requirements for determining eligibility with respect to height and weight at every show. Event Committees may delegate this responsibility to Superintendents/Show Secretaries. All-breed shows shall be required to have at least one complete set of wickets (two sets for shows with entries of 1,000 or more) and at least one digital scale with a platform of sufficient size to safely accommodate all weighable breeds. A certified and stamped weight is also required.

Specialty Shows and Group Shows where measurable or weighable breeds are entered shall provide the appropriate wicket(s) and/or a digital scale with a platform of sufficient size to safely accommodate all breeds that might be measured or weighed at the event. A certified and stamped weight is also required.

This amendment was proposed by the Delegate Dog Show Rules Committee.

These changes eliminate the italics, rewords the section to add language to specify that all equipment must meet AKC requirements, and inserts it into the rule. The change also generalizes the wording for wickets to eliminate the need to modify in the future and clarifies expectation for a number of sets of wickets and scales that must be provided at all-breed group or specialty shows.

Chapter 6. Field Trial Committee, Field Trial Secretary, Premium Lists

Section 4. The last sentence in this section.

The premium list for each licensed or member field trial shall contain all the information set forth on the questionnaire form as approved by the American Kennel Club and shall be of official size.

Chapter 6. Field Trial Committee, Field Trial Secretary, Premium Lists

Section 4. The last sentence in this section.

The premium list <u>and/or announcements</u> for each licensed or member field trial shall contain all the information set forth on the <u>official AKC Event Application</u> form as approved by the American Kennel Club, <u>except the addresses for the judges</u>, <u>trial chair and club officers need only include the city and state</u>. The <u>premium list</u> shall be of official size.

This recommendation was first proposed by the Beagle Advisory Committee. The Delegate Field Trial and Hunting Test Committee supported this change for all types of field trials.

Removes the requirement to show the street address in the premium list for the judges, trial chair and club officers.
